

The Lord's Supper: One table, Many Guests

Presiding at the Table

The oneness of the body of Christ symbolized by the love of God to which the Lord's Supper points is why celebrating is at "every stated meeting" of the church was the "capital proposition" on which Campbell was most insistent. He believed that everything else about "the breaking of the loaf" was preliminary to this purpose. Observance at every gathering was essential to the nurture of the moral health of the Christian community. From what he said about it, it is clear that for Campbell what the Lord's Supper represented made it the heart of Christian worship. For Campbell the bread and the cup were symbols of an act of God, and the institution of the Lord's Supper itself as that which no person other than Jesus could have so established.
