
Sunda School

Unity: One Church and One World

Unity is Urgent

Beyond the linking of unity and freedom, leaders in our tradition have often made several claims, the first being that unity is urgent. Every student of Disciples history must surely have worked to undermine sectarian complacency in the body of Christ. The unity of Christians is not simply one item on a list of ecclesiastical priorities; it is the heart of the gospel, to be pursued and proclaimed with passionate urgency. Barton Stone: "If we oppose the union of believers, we oppose directly the will of God, the prayer of Jesus, the spirit of piety, and the salvation of the world. "Thomas Campbell: Division among Christ's followers is "anti-Christian," "antiscriptural," and "antinatural." It has "rent and ruined the Church of God." "In a word, it is productive of confusion and every evil work." Peter Ainslie: "the greatest necessity of modern times is the unity of the Church of Christ. No other issue exceeds it in importance."
