It is hard to believe that Advent begins in less than two weeks. This important time in our faith lives is a time in which we prepare for the birth of the Christ child in our midst. A time in which we hope and prepare for the light shining in the darkness, knowing that darkness can NOT and will NOT overcome it.

How are you preparing for Advent with your family? One tradition I am going to start this year with Nugget is an Advent Book Calendar. 


