Reflection

Christmas is less than 2 weeks away, and I know everybody is busy with shopping, cooking, parties, and lots of preparations. I can't help but wonder, do we get so busy with the "stuff" of Christmas that we forget about the true meaning of Christmas? Our Advent Study this year is about not only making room for God in our hearts, but also making room for our neighbors as well.

I remember hearing stories about how my great-grandfather would bring random people home for dinner, especially around Christmas time. They would be people he met out and about that day who needed a hot meal, or the homeless he would see downtown on the square. It didn't matter. If they were in need he would help them.
