Romans: The Letter that Changed The World Bible Study

Romans is the 6th book in the New Testament. It was scratched on parchment during the first century AD by a Jewish convert to Christianity named Paul. This letter, which was directed to Christians who lived in the capital city of Rome, Italy, contained teachings and doctrines that would change the world. It was countercultural and revolutionary in a day when Rome ruled its citizens-both in Italy and throughout the Empire-with an iron fist. Romans is one of the most fascinating letters ever written.

You are invited to participate in the last 6 sessions of the Bible Study titled Romans: The Letter that Changed The World starting Tuesday, September 20, at 10:00 a.m. in Church Parlor. The first 6 sessions were held in April and May, but new persons are encouraged to join for the last 6 session. The sessions include bible study and a video segment plus sharing and prayer. Each study presents another new perspective on Paul's words, how they would have been received in his day, and how they still are to be applied today in our lives.

Please sign up on the sign up sheet by the church office or contact the church office. Jean Miller and Jaylene Arnett will be leading the study. There is no cost for the study book.
