Reflection

Dear Members and Friends of First Christian Church,

I am honored to serve as your Intentional Interim Minister beginning this past Sunday, October 2. My work here is to pastor the congregation and to do so in some specific ways around three questions:

- 1. Who are we as First Christian Church?
- 2. Who are our neighbors?
- 3. What is God uniquely calling First Christian Church to do?

We'll explore these question using five focal points:

- 1. Heritage looks at our past, our identity, and what we want to carry forward into the future
- 2. Leadership strengthens, support, and develops leadership within the congregation and beyond
- 3. Mission develops a description of what we are called to do and how we will do that work
- 4. Connection explores connections beyond the congregation to the community, the region, and beyond.
- 5. Future synthesizing the interim work and developing next steps for the congregation's process.

This work excites me and energizes me. Also, it demands energy and focus to stay on track so that we accomplish together what you desire to happen in this interim period. In other words, we are not just holding space or biding time. We're working to respond to God's call on First Christian Church and each of our lives. This work very much involves all of you as a part of the congregation.

To that end, I'm asking for your help. We are forming a Transition Team, a steering committee, to help lead the work of the interim time.

We would like you to submit the names of three people in the congregation you trust the most. We will compile a list of names mentioned and use that to recruit members of the Team.


