Reflection

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

I want to thank you for your assistance in forming the Transition Team. I also want to thank the members of the Transition Team for saying yes to serving on the team. The members of the Transition Team are: Barb Gimple, Marie Harding, Carl Headrick, Janet Lostutter, Jean Miller, and Judy Moore.

I offer this summation of their job description for your information:

The Transition Team steers the interim ministry process. We develop the process through which the whole congregation can participate as fully as possible in healing, growing, and moving in good directions. Our decisions are process decisions—what kinds of events and activities, questionnaires and workshops, etc., will be most useful. The congregation or its governing body will continue to make policy decisions about the life of the congregation. We organize and facilitate the special activities such as workshops and gatherings for the interim process.

We guide the Congregation in asking good questions, particularly focused as:

- Our identity Who are we as a Congregation?
- Our history, the highs and lows, how have we changed recently?
- Our context Who is our neighbor?
- How do we describe our community and its greatest needs? How has our community changed in the last 20 years?
- In what ways are we currently serving our community?
- Our calling What is God calling us to do? In light of who we are (our identity) and where we are planted (our context), what is God writing for this next chapter in our lives together?

We decide the best ways to conduct conversations and gather insights from the Congregation about the above questions and lead the Congregation through that process. We monitor the whole process. We look and listen. We encourage positive and constructive input from the Congregation and leaders.

Throughout this time, we will be working to communicate regularly about the process and offering opportunities for you to engage the questions that will guide the congregation's next steps. In all of this work, prayer needs to be central to our shared work - among the team and among the congregation. I encourage you to keep the team, the congregation, and myself in your prayers throughout this time and ask God to show all of us what our most faithful response is in all things.


