Reflection

Dear Friends,

Scripture includes many, many stories of visions and dreams. In Acts 2, Luke recounts Peter's Pentecost sermon quoting him, "your young shall see visions, and your old shall dream dreams" (Acts 2:17). These visions and dreams that Peter proclaims will come are a gift of God's Spirit and, I believe, visions of God's Garden of Love. They are visions of what God intends for all creation. In Genesis 28, Jacob dreams of a ladder that reminds him of the connection between God and creation. These stories in scripture remind us of the sacredness, the divine connection, of all things.

As we enter Advent and approach Christmas, I invite you to open your hearts and minds to these dreams. Then notice through these questions what God is doing. How is God reminding you of the sacredness of all things? How is God reminding you of the divine connection of time, people, space, and knowing? How is God being revealed to you in the coming of the Christ Child? What is God calling First Christian Church of Emporia to be and to do?


