### Reflection

Dear Friends,

The Transition Team has been diligently working to identify goals, work, and challenges that are before the congregation. Their work has been steeped in prayer and scripture reflections and study of written resources. They workshopped and refined our initial conversation at our Thanksgiving Luncheon. Currently, they are workshopping and planning a whole congregation conversation about the core values and dreams of the congregation that we anticipate having in January.

I, along with members of the Transition Team, have received some questions about when they would present a plan and options that the congregation can decide upon. We hear the sense of urgency in your questions. The response that you've heard has been that the Transition Team is not presenting options nor a plan, but instead will create opportunities for the whole congregation to articulate a plan in response to this question - "Who does God call First Christian Church to be and what does God call First Christian Church to do?" It is a big question and takes some time to answer. Consideration of the question requires time and participation from the whole body. The Transition Team cannot give you a purpose or options of purpose - those would be their preferences. I cannot give you a purpose because that would be mine and not your's. Instead, we listen to God who gives you purpose.

We'll continue to keep you updated. If you'd like to have a conversation about this process, please reach out to one of the Transition Team members or myself.




