## Reflection

Dear Friends,

What are you taking up for Lent?

"Wait a minute!", you're saying to yourself right now. "Aren't you supposed to ask, 'What are you giving up for Lent?"" Well, yes, that is the usual question that people associate with the Lenten season. And, it fits this stretch of 40 days (excluding Sundays) between Ash Wednesday and Easter. Sacrifice, self-denial, and repentance as turning in a new direction all emphasize this idea of giving up something for Lent. I wonder, though, does giving up chocolate or soda or coffee really make a difference in our faith journeys?

Lent is not just a season of saying, "No!" Lent primarily is a season of saying "Yes!" In the early church, it was the time for final preparations for baptism as new believers would die to their old way of life and rise from the waters of baptism to a new life. Early baptismal fonts sometimes were even shaped as sarcophagi to emphasize this element - dying to our old lives, and rising to our new lives. So the "No" of Lent is ultimately about saying "Yes" to God. We say "No" so that we can offer a bigger "Yes" to God. If we are just giving up something for Lent and not thinking about the bigger "Yes" to God, then our no doesn't really mean anything. So as you prepare for this Lenten season and you prepare to give something up, why are you choosing to do that practice? What are you saying "No" to in order to offer that bigger "Yes" to God?

So I'll ask again. What are you taking up for Lent?


